Academic scholarships at Virginia Tech are available through the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid (<a href="https://finaid.vt.edu">https://finaid.vt.edu</a>) as well as through the various colleges and academic departments. Please take the following steps to assure your consideration of all scholarship opportunities at Virginia Tech.

- I. Complete the Free Application for Students Financial Aid (FAFSA) **online on time**. January 15, 2018 is the Priority Deadline for 2018-2019 FAFSA.
- II. Complete the Virginia Tech general scholarship application online in the Scholarship Central system. Prospective students should:
  - 1. Apply for admission to VT at http://admissions.vt.edu/apply.html
  - 2. Create a Guest Account using your 9-digit application ID number from Step 1. For more information on the Guest Account and FAQs, please visit <a href="http://admissions.vt.edu/apply/guest-account.html">http://admissions.vt.edu/apply/guest-account.html</a>
  - 3. Use the Guest Account login credentials to log in to the VT Scholarship Central at https://vt.academicworks.com/

- III. If invites, complete the Virginia Tech Honors Program Application in a timely manner. These are issued by invitation only.

The B.S. degree in Biochemistry is offered through two colleges: College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS) and College of Science (COS). COS is one of the largest colleges at Virginia Tech and has fewer college-level scholarships per student. CALS is one of the smaller colleges on campus, so proportionately, it has more college-level scholarships to offer to its students. Biochemistry majors seeking scholarship money are usually recommended to enroll in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences. Applications for CALS scholarships are due December 7, 2017 for the 2018-2019 academic year.
